Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to Sanjeevani Ayurvedic Medical College, Village- Kudana Chak, Near Brijghat, Distt-Amroha-244235, Uttar Pradesh (AYU0372) with intake capacity of 60 seats [instead of 100 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Sanjeevani Ayurvedic Medical College, Village- Kudana Chak, Near Brijghat, Distt-Amroha-244235, Uttar Pradesh (AYU0372)**, inspection of your college was conducted on **05.02.2024** and **06.02.2024** and re-visited on **18.03.2024** and **19.03.2024** on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
- Furthermore, the college denied to conduct the re-visit and Medical Assessment & Rating Board, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine was in a receipt of a letter vide ref. no. **S-2024/Visitation/575 dated 18.03.2024** wherein the college mentioned that **"due to casualty (death) in our management."**
- Further, Denial of Conditional Permission for the academic session 2024-25 was issued to the college** due to the following reasons vide letter of even no. dated 26.07.2024: -
 - The college denied to conduct the re-visit scheduled on 18th and 19th March 2024 **saying that, due to "casualty (death) in our management** the college unable to arranged/conduct the visitation". **Further, the hearing committee observed that the denial of visitation of apex regulatory body and also the submission made by the college is not justified.**
 - It is to also note that there is no provision in the rules to deny the visitation. **Hence, the hearing committee came to a conclusion that the submissions made by the college cannot be considered.**
 - Further, It is pertinent to mention here that **as per section 28(1) (c) of NCISM Act, 2020**, Medical Assessment and Rating Board can carry out inspections for assessing and rating of institutions by any third-party agency or persons authorized by Medical Assessment & Rating Board, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and it shall be obligatory on such institutions to provide access to such agency for person. **Further, as per section 29(7) of NCISM Act, 2020**, Medical Assessment & Rating Board, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine can conduct assessment of any institute at any time without prior notice. **Therefore, it is considered that if the college does not allow the visitors to execute their assignment, the college is not following the NCISM Act, 2020.**
- Further, **college filed a first appeal in the Commission which was later dismissed by the Commission vide ref. no. NCISM/Comm/OPT Appeal/(2024-25)-(U.P) Dated 09.09.2024.** Again, the college filed a **second appeal to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi** and Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi through a letter vide ref. no. **L-14014/8/2024-AEP-I dated 11.11.2024** directed the **MARBISM, NCISM** that the visitation of the college may be carried out again. **Therefore, on the direction of Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi, visitation of the college was again conducted on 18.11.2024 and 19.11.2024 through hybrid mode.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder. On

careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified and approved criteria due to the following shortcoming:-**

In view of above, On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above, **an opportunity of virtual hearing** to your college was provided vide the MARB-ISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even number** dated **21.11.2024** to appear before the designated Hearing Committee on **22.11.2024**, to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the conditional permission to the college with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2024-25.**

7. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no. S-2024/Hearing/2510, dated 22.11.2024** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dr. Dinesh kumar Sharma and Dr. Lokdeep Sharma, Principal**, appeared before the Hearing Committee on **22.11.2024** and made their submission virtually as well as written, against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

For example- the college having sixty-one to hundred seats intake capacity shall have minimum forty total faculties, out of which minimum nineteen Professors or Readers covering all fourteen Departments.)

8. Further, it is observed that the college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission for UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the Academic Session 2024-25. However, fulfilling for Conditional Permission for 60 seats [instead of 100 seats] in UG (BAMS) course as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2024-25, wherein it is mentioned that:-

a. **"For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10 % of total intake capacity."**

Accordingly as per Schedule-V Note (iv) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty-one to hundred intake capacity shall not exceed more than twenty percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation, college is having only **33 total eligible teaching faculties**.

There is deficiency of **03 teachers** for issuance of Conditional Permission for academic session 2024-25 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. **Therefore, in accordance with seat reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 30% of total intake capacity.**

b. **"In case of non-availability of any teaching staff in the department (vacant department) for intake capacity up to 61 to 100 seats, seat reduction policy shall be applied considering the deficiency of one (01) teacher for 61 to 100 seats intake capacity in each of the vacant department."**

Further, in the **department of Rachana Sharir**, no faculty is available against the requirement of minimum 02 Higher Faculty and 01 Lower Faculty.

Therefore, in accordance with seat reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity.

Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats [instead of 100 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

9. Therefore, **Conditional Permission is granted to Sanjeevani Ayurvedic Medical College, Village- Kudana Chak, Near Brijghat, Distt-Amroha-244235, Uttar Pradesh (AYU0372) with intake capacity of 60 seats [instead of 100 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following **conditions as mentioned below:-**

- I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **60 seats [instead of 100 seats]** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
10. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
11. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year.**
12. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
13. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Point no. 7 above.

14. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
15. **The issued conditional permission is subject to the ratification in the ensuing Board meeting.**
